Another Contract in Place to Continue Construction in Iraq

Baghdad, Iraq – NANA Pacific, a Native Alaskan Owned Corporation from Anchorage, Alaska, USA was awarded a \$70 million contract by the Coalition Provisional Authority March 31 to provide a variety of services in connection with improving Iraqi seaports. The initial work will be the dredging of the Port of Umm Qasr. The job provides for no less than 1.32 million cubic meters of dredging. The dredging has commenced and will begin the process of opening Iraqi ports to world class trade.

Other work to be done under the contract includes general and electrical construction, port operations, crane repairs, communications infrastructure development, transportation support and security.

With the award of over \$5 billion in March alone, the U.S. now has up to approximately \$8 billion of its 2004 supplemental appropriation working for construction of Iraqi infrastructure. A portion of the work has already started through the direction of the Coalition Provisional Authority's Program Management Office (PMO), the U.S. Agency for International Development and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. The items in **bold** are the major construction contracts awarded in March. The PMO envisions about \$12,600,000,000 of the U.S. supplemental appropriation going to construction.

The PMO manages the \$18.4 billion appropriated by the U.S. Congress to support the reconstruction of Iraqi infrastructure. In broadest terms, this office is responsible for all activities associated with program, project, asset, construction and financial management of that portion of the reconstruction effort undertaken by the U.S.
